**SENATOR CORY BOOKER TO PUBLISH
STAND
WITH ST. MARTIN'S PRESS
ON NOVEMBER 11, 2025**

(New York, NY -- May 28, 2025) – It was announced today that Senator Cory Booker will publish a new book, **STAND**, with St. Martin's Press on November 11, 2025. St. Martin's Publishing Group Executive Editor Tim Bartlett acquired World publishing rights from Jennifer Joel and Esther Newberg at CAA. The book will be available in hardcover, ebook and audio formats.

Senator Booker captivated Americans across the political spectrum with his remarkable 25-hour speech on the Senate floor, when he spoke out eloquently and forcefully against the Trump administration's relentless challenges to civil liberties, government institutions, the rule of law, and America's international standing. In the process, Booker outlasted the record for longest continuous Senate floor speech set by segregationist Strom Thurmond during a filibuster of the Civil Rights Act of 1957, which was delivered at another time of great uncertainty for our country when it felt like the odds were hopelessly stacked against justice and unity.

Tim Bartlett, inspired by Booker's remarkable oratory marathon, approached the Senator to discuss how his powerful message could be amplified and adapted into a compelling book.

STAND explores how our choices today shape the future—and offers a passionate call to conscience and a guide for courageous engagement. At its core is the conviction that it's not enough to fight against someone or something—we must also stand for something greater. **STAND** is an urgent call to renew our shared values and commit to endurance, courage, and principled action.

Senator Cory Booker states: *"This book is about the virtues vital to our success as a nation and lessons we can draw from generations of Americans who fought for them. Now is not the time to surrender to cynicism or abandon our most noble ideals. Now is the time to defiantly declare like our ancestors before us: I too stand for America."*

CORY BOOKER is the senior United States senator from New Jersey. Booker earned bachelor's and master's degrees at Stanford University, attended Oxford University as a Rhodes Scholar, and earned a law degree at Yale University. He served as mayor of Newark for seven years before becoming New Jersey's first Black senator, and only the fourth popularly elected Black senator in US history. Booker is a national leader in the effort to expand economic opportunities and reform our criminal justice and healthcare systems. He lives in Newark's Central Ward.
