FLATIRON BOOKS TO PUBLISH NEW BOOK BY SOPHIA BUSH

For the first time, the beloved actress, activist, entrepreneur, and podcast host recounts the moments that have shaped her life, on- and off-screen, in *And I Will Tell You Mine*, set to publish on October 27, 2026

(New York, NY—May 14, 2026) Megan Lynch, EVP and Publisher of Flatiron Books, announced today that Sophia Bush will publish **AND I WILL TELL YOU MINE: Notes from a Life in Progress** with the Macmillan division. The acquisition was facilitated by Cait Hoyt at CAA. Publication is set for **October 27, 2026** with Flatiron Books Executive Editor Julianna Haubner to edit.

“I have long admired Sophia for the fearlessness, passion, and integrity she brings to the characters she portrays, the causes she champions, and the truths she tells,” says Haubner. “To watch her now step into the role of author, and witness the vulnerability, wisdom, and wit in the pages of this fantastic book, which tells her story as only she could — and generously contains timely and resonant lessons for us all — has been a true delight and privilege.”

Best known for her roles as Brooke Davis on the beloved teen drama *One Tree Hill*, Detective Erin Lindsey on *Chicago P.D.*, and Dr. Cass Beckman on *Grey's Anatomy*, Sophia Bush has connected with millions around the world through the women whose stories she brings to life on-screen. Now, she tells the most important story yet: her own.

“After years of writing about the world, I finally felt called to write a book that reflects on my own life, and shares my truth in my own words,” says Bush. “This is my opportunity to celebrate who I am and all that has shaped me. Every experience — good and bad, ordinary and unique, challenging and triumphant — has led me to this moment. I am so grateful for the journey. Through these pages, I hope to encourage readers to show themselves grace, and to honor their capacity for change. And I hope to remind us all of the strength, resilience, and relentless joy that lives within us. We can choose to claim it at any moment.”

With unflinching honesty, she opens up about her bohemian childhood in Los Angeles and the unexpected road from journalism student to actor; the life-changing decade of *One Tree Hill*, where she navigated relationships on- and off-screen and fought for her character's integrity; the realities of marriage and divorce in the spotlight; and her years in Chicago, where a dream job forced her into two lives—a badge-wearing protector in one, and a woman in need of protecting in the other. She also offers a side of herself that's not often seen: the curious, human, laugh-out-loud-funny friend and fellow traveler.

Beautifully written, and at turns both personal and universal, *And I Will Tell You Mine* is an unforgettable journey through becoming, un-becoming, and becoming again; embracing the

She is a member of the Directors Guild of America and has starred in an impressive range of television and film projects including *John Tucker Must Die*, *Incredibles 2*, the CW's hit series *One Tree Hill*, and Dick Wolf's NBC hit series *Chicago P.D.* Bush also starred in and served as a producer on the television series *Good Sam*, for CBS. Most recently, she joined the cast of *Grey's Anatomy* as the recurring role of Dr. Cass Beckman. She will soon be seen in Hulu's new television series, *Count My Lies*. Since 2019, she has been the host of the popular podcast *Work in Progress with Sophia Bush*. She was a co-host of *Drama Queens* alongside Hilarie Burton Morgan, Robert Buckley, and Bethany Joy Lenz from 2021-2025. Beyond entertainment, Sophia is a dedicated activist and philanthropist, with a large focus on female empowerment causes. She is a General Partner and investor in Union Heritage Ventures, a majority African American and women-owned venture capital firm, and is an advisor for Fashionkind and the First Women's Bank. Sophia co-founded and sits on the board for I am a voter®, and is a part-owner of Angel City FC. *And I Will Tell You Mine* is her first book.
